Paul has been assigned to Neighborhood Stabilization Unit 10 in Brooklyn, as well as the 70 and 109 Precincts and the Street Narcotics Enforcement Unit (SNEU). As a Sergeant, he was assigned to the Police Academy, where he was elected to the position of SBA delegate.

While assigned to SNEU in April 1993, Paul's wife Mary, a police officer in the 70 Precinct, was shot numerous times while saving the life of a fellow officer during an arrest situation. Her recovery was long, arduous and nothing short of miraculous.

Paul earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Labor Studies from the National Labor College and a Master of Science in Organizational Leadership from Mercy College.
